Dear Friend:

Today, about one in four people living with HIV in the United States are women and girls 13 and older. Some of those women and girls live right here in the city of Pittsburgh, in Allegheny County, as well as surrounding counties. Only about half of women living with HIV are getting care, and only four in 10 of them have the virus under control. Women face unique HIV risks and challenges that can prevent them from getting needed care and treatment. Addressing these issues remains critical to achieving an HIV and AIDS-free generation. This year we are making a special effort to ask Churches and Houses of Worship to join our effort.

On March 9, 2019, Educating Teens about HIV/AIDS Inc. will observe National Women and Girls HIV/ AIDS Awareness Day to bring attention to this important public health issue. The purpose of the observance is to raise **awareness** of the impact of **HIV** and **AIDS** on **women and girls**. The **2019 theme** is **“Together for Love: Stop HIV Stigma.”**
